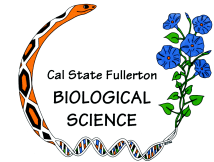

Tiffany 2000

- 15 May: Bud sprouts from the soil
- 13 June: Spadix maximum height 59"
- 13 June: Peak bloom, fully open
- 18 June: Spent flower, fell over



Taffy 2001

- 15 May: Bud sprouts from the soil
- 24 June: Spadix maximum height 34"
- 24 June: Peak bloom, fully open
- 10 July: Spent flower, dried, seeds growing



Tiffany 2003

- 28 March: Bud sprouts from the soil
- Spadix maximum height
- Peak bloom, fully open
- Spent flower, fell over
